Articles — Grade 1 (a, an, the)

Articles are tiny helper words that come before nouns. They point to**one** thing (*a, an*) or a **particular** thing (*the*).

What are articles?

a

Use before a **consonant sound**.

a cat a bag a red ball

an

Use before a **vowel sound** (a, e, i, o, u).

an apple an egg an umbrella

the

Use for something **specific** or **unique**.

the sun the moon the Taj Mahal

A vs. An — follow the sound

Use a when it starts with a consonant sound

- a dog, a toy, a yellow balloon
- a unicorn (starts with "yoo" sound ? consonant sound)

Use an when it starts with a vowel sound

- an orange, an ice-cream
- **an** hour (silent *h* ? "our" sound)

Tip: Say the word aloud. If it begins with a vowel sound (a/e/i/o/u), usean. Otherwise, use a.

Unique things

the sun the moon the sky

Famous names

the Taj Mahal \(\) the Ganga \(\) the Himalayas

When no article is needed (Grade-1 friendly)

Talking in general (plural)

Cats like milk. (Not "The cats", unless you mean some *specific* cats.)

Names of people & places

Ria lives in **Delhi**. (No article before names like Ria, Delhi.)

Noun / Phrase	Correct article	Why?
apple	an apple	Vowel sound (a).
cat	a cat	Consonant sound (c).
umbrella	an umbrella	Vowel sound ("uh").
unicorn	a unicorn	"yoo" sound ? consonant sound.
hour	an hour	Silent h ? vowel sound.
sun	the sun	Unique thing.
Taj Mahal	the Taj Mahal	Famous/specific name.
oranges	— or the	General: no article. Specific: use the.

Common mistakes (quick fixes)

Letters vs. sounds

We choose by **sound**! a **u**nicorn ? "yoo" ? **a**

Forgetting "the" for unique things

Write: **the** sun / **the** moon

Adding "the" before names

Do not write "the Ria" or "the Delhi".

General vs. specific

Oranges are sweet. (general) • The oranges in my bag (specific)
